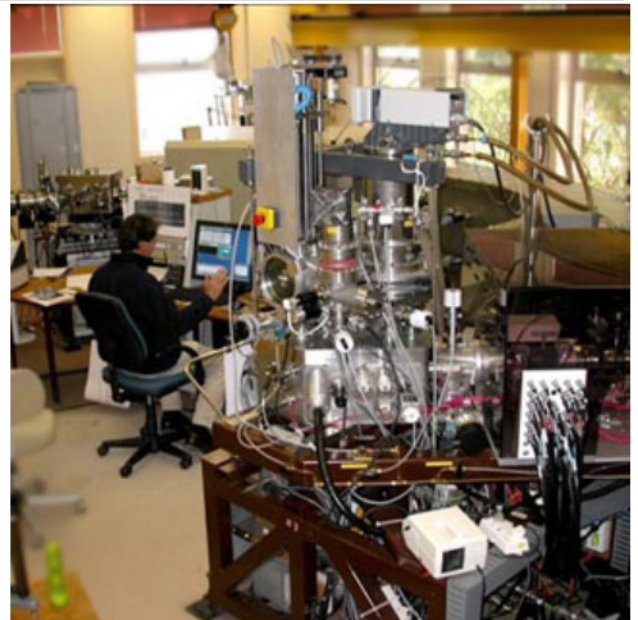

The principal applicant must be a member of the Western Australian Division of the Society, and domiciled in a Western Australian Institution.

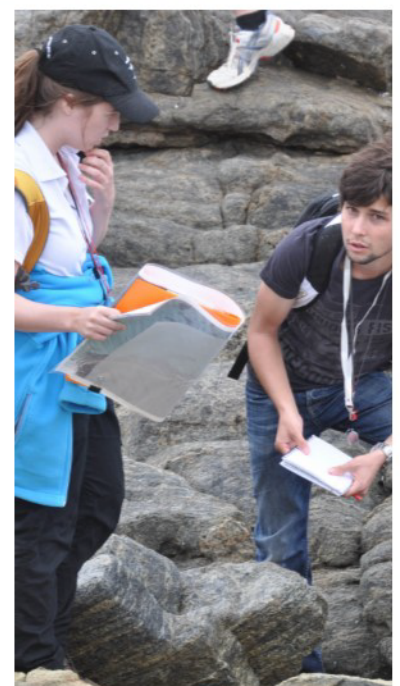
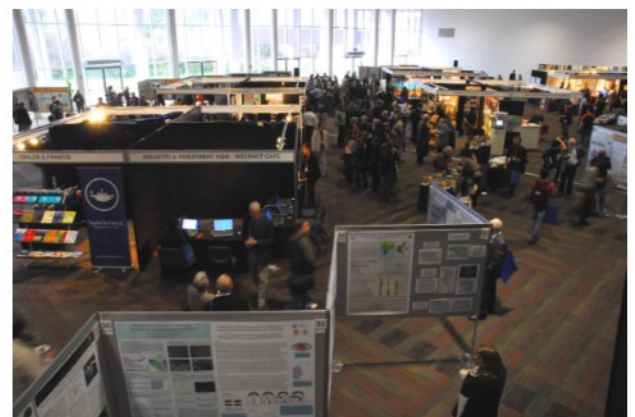
